When:

Monday, July 17, 2023 at 5:00 pm through Saturday, July 22, 2023 at 12:00 pm. For insurance reasons, early arrivals and dismissals are not allowed. Camper registration runs from 5:00pm – 7:00 pm on Monday, July 17th, 2023.

Where:

Camp 4 Star is held at the environmental learning center in Millersylvania State Park. The park is located on Deep Lake, about 12 miles south of Olympia. The center boasts a private swimming beach, dining hall with a well equipped kitchen, large fire pit with bench seating, 16 camper cabins, 3 staff cabins, and separate boys and girls restrooms.

What:

A week-long summer camp packed full of fun, morning devotions, Bible study and topic discussion, singing, arts and crafts, swimming, boating, fishing, volleyball, campfires, evening games, award night, and evening devotions.

Who:

Camp 4 Star is for boys and girls entering grades 4 to 9 in fall 2023 (ages 9-14)!

Camp 4 Star has a camp director, registered nurse, camp Pastor, song leader, activity leaders, lifeguard, cooks(with food handling permits from the Department of Health), and camp counselors are all volunteers for Camp 4 Star and are members from the Northwest ELS/WELS congregations.

Registration Cost: (includes t-shirt, food, housing, supplies, equipment use, and insurance)

Parking:

A Washington State Park representative may ask you to purchase a day use pass if you will be parking and waiting to get into the ELC before the gates are opened at 5:00pm on Monday or 12:00pm on Saturday. This is not a cost that Camp 4 Star will cover for those individuals arriving before the actual drop off or pick up times. Those who have a valid Discover Pass do not need the day use pass. - Swimsuit and towel
- Extra Shoes
- Air mattress (mattress/cots provided)

Restricted Items(will be confiscated)

- All electronics, including: cell phones, mp3 players, radios, CD/DVD players, hand-held games, ect...
- Guns/Knives(including fishing knives)
- Tobacco/Alcohol/Drugs(medically necessary drugs must be left with the nurse)
- Fireworks



Application & Contact

Information

Acceptance and Deadlines:

Applications may be submitted online or mailed in. Full payment or minimum \$95 deposit is required with your application. Make checks payable to Camp 4 Star or visit camp4star.com to make payment online. Any outstanding fees are due upon check-in at camp. Cancellations are accepted through July 10th, 2023. Prior to June 1st, 2023 entire payment or deposit is refundable minus a \$10.00 processing fee. After June 1st, 2023 the deposit amount of \$95.00 is non-refundable, if paid in full the difference between the deposit amount and full payment will be refunded. Applications will be accepted on first received basis. For planning purposes please submit applications by June 30, 2023. Any applications received after space has been filled or after the deadline has passed will be placed on a waiting list in the order in which they were received. Waiting list applicants will be contacted in turn if space becomes available. All applications require a completed medical & consent form at check-in.

Camper Mail:

Emergency Contact Number:

In case of an emergency during camp, you may call either of the Camp Directors: Rachel Austin (253) 861-9662 or Tim Scherschel (425) 212-8173. These numbers are for emergency use only.

Directions to Millersylvania State Park:

From I-5, take the Maytown/Little Rock Exit (exit 95)

Follow the signs to Maytown. Proceed through Maytown until you come to a "T" in the road. Take a left and follow that road to the state park. The park will be on your left.

Follow the signs in the park to the "Environmental Learning Center" entrance, which is located at the end of the parking area, near the boat launch. Look for the white log gate. Follow that road up to the camp dining hall and parking area. Registration will take place inside the dining hall.



Rules & Requirements

Canteen Money Control:

At registration, canteen money will be collected and logged on a card file. Canteen money is limited to \$10. There is a spending limit of \$2 per day. If a balance remains at the end of the week, it will be refunded at checkout on Saturday.

Boating or Canoeing:

Campers must take a counselor or staff member with them when boating and are required to wear life-jackets while on a boat or canoe.

Swimming:

For safety purposes, the buddy system for swimming will be used. This means that campers are required to have another person with them at all times when swimming. Lifeguard(s) may call "buddy check" and each camper will raise their hands along with their buddy's hand.

Damages:

Each camper will be held responsible for the expense to repair and/or replace anything damaged or lost at camp, belonging to campers, other individuals, Camp 4 Star, or the U.S. Government.

Restricted Items:

Restricted items include all electronic devices (including cell phones, mp3 players, etc.), firearms, knives, alcohol, tobacco, drugs, and fireworks. In addition, a staff member may, at their discretion, restrict any item that is used in a disruptive or destructive manner, or is used in a harmful way towards other campers or staff. Any camper found to be in possession of restricted items will have the items immediately confiscated until Saturday. All effort to return confiscated items to the camper will be made, but not guaranteed.

Behavior

For the orderly operation of Camp 4 Star it is necessary to implement the following rule: any camper or counselor that becomes disruptive, destructive or a risk to the other campers or staff will be required to leave camp immediately at the sole discretion of the Camp Director and/or attending board members. The parents or guardian will be contacted and immediately required to pick the camper up at the camp and will forfeit the remainder of the week's camping fee.
